Family Plan Decide where to meet your family. Choose a meeting place outside your home or in a flood-safe place outside your neighborhood. Find alternative routes away from any flood prone roads. Make a copy for each family member to keep.
Important Family and Emergency Phone numbers List important emergency numbers to get help and numbers to contact your family with. Ask your parents to choose a friend or family member out of town to call in an emergency. Learn this number by heart. Practice what you would say to let your family know where you are.
